Although no one has come directly from these encounters, God has sent two families that are now coming faithfully. Andy and Angela and their boys Alex and Alan, and David, his wife Kathy and their two children Jonas, and Ellie. I mentioned them in the quick update last month and I am so encouraged at their faithfulness, and their growth spiritually. **Pray specifically for David and Kathy their two children are special needs children and raising them here in the city is taxing to say the least.** We had our First Responders Sunday and it was so exciting to see the Firemen from the firehouse across from the church come and worship with us. It was truly and encouragement to the people to see fruit from their labor. They worked with us to create a basket full of goodies for the firemen, and then helped with preparation and literature distribution, so to have them there was a huge encouragement from the Lord. In October we had Pastors Wife Appreciation Day. We had cake and a gift from the people for Mrs. Jamie. It was great seeing all the folks rally around Mrs. Jamie and show her such love and support. **Pray for Jamie, her spinal cord is being pinched in her neck by a disc and the doctors want to start her on injections to offer her some relief, ultimately they want her to have surgery so please pray with us about having discernment and wisdom in this matter.** We are looking forward to our Thanksgiving service on Nov. 23rd. We will have our morning service followed by a thanksgiving meal. My family will prepare the turkey and several sides, and the people of the church are all bringing dishes to go with it. I love the fact that our Thanksgiving dinner will look like most of your International dinners at missions conferences. Sheldon is brining Shepards Pie, I'm excited about this because Sheldon is Guyanese, and this intrigues me. Angela and Andy are bringing traditional Chinese dumplings, and Ereen is bringing Pasta with Béchamel sauce, which looks like lasagna. Erica is bringing a Dominican rice dish. We are so happy to see all the people jump in and want to participate. We will have our first Sunday Afternoon service right after that lunch. It is my desire to do this again in December and introduce to our people the concept of and afternoon service. If they respond well and have a desire to attend than we will Lord willing make it a permanent service each Sunday. I know many of you are saying its Sunday Evening service, your just supposed to do that. I know this and you know this, but people that have never been to church don't know this. **Pray with me that the people respond well, and have a desire to spend more time both in the word of God and with Gods People.** I pray for you all often as you hold the ropes for us and I am so thankful for your partnership with us to reach this extremely needy mission field. **Did I mention that our city just elected a Muslim Socialist Mayor?
