Thank you so much for your continued prayers and financial support. We acknowledge without your sacrificial giving of money and prayers we couldn't be here doing what we are doing for the Lord. As I write this in early January reflecting on all that God has done in 2025, I am simply overwhelmed. **WOTC launched in June and in just six months time we have had 4 salvation testimonies, 4 baptisms, and a regular attendance averaging 20+ people every week, God is so Good!!**

November was an exciting month for us as we continued with our discipleship and going through the book of John in our Sunday Morning Services. We had new visitors in November and I credit it to God's provision through our soul winning efforts. We knock doors and no one from those encounters have come yet, but God keeps sending others in. WOTC is in a very Jewish/Asian community and many are cold to the Gospel. But God is blessing the labor in Fresh Meadows. **Please continue to pray for these efforts and that God will be glorified through them.** We were able to go to Georgia and spend time with family for Thanksgiving week and it was a great blessing. We celebrated Thanksgiving as a church on Sunday Nov. 30th and had 30 people there. It was encouraging to see the people jump in and bring food. I encouraged them to bring dishes from their culture. We had turkey and dressing sure, but we also had, cottage pie, Chinese dumplings, and Egyptian Béchamel Sauce with pasta. We have been having a lunch fellowship at least once a month but in November after the Thanksgiving meal, we had our first afternoon service, and I was encouraged that everyone stayed.

In December we paused our study of John to look at the Birth of Jesus. We again in December had new people come and I am so happy that so many have decided to make WOTC their church home. In December like in Nov. we had a big fellowship meal for Christmas. Again many people brought food to contribute and the fellowship was amazing. Jamie's Mom and Dad traveled up for Christmas this year and our children loved it. Having the grandparents here for the holidays really made it special. During the morning service for our Christmas Service Jamie, Lila, and Jamie's dad sang a Christmas Special and it was a great blessing. In December after our Christmas Dinner we again had an afternoon service. I asked Jamie's mom to share her testimony and it was a real encouragement. Jamie's mom has been through so much and her reliance and trust in Jesus reminds me of the woman with the blood disorder for 12 years in Luke 8. She just had faith, and Jesus handles all the rest. I told the people that God had been burdening my heart about our need for more church not less. I told them that It was my desire to have an afternoon service every Sunday. The people unanimously agreed and were so excited for it.

Pray for us as we start up our next round of discipleship with Angela, and her two sons, Alan and Alex. Also joining us is my daughter Mollie and a newcomer to the church Jenny. Its so exciting to see so many hungry for the word of God and desiring to grow in their Christian walk. **Pray for our people to continue to grow in the Lord. Please also pray for our city as it transitions into new territory with our new mayor. Pray for WOTC to be a witness for Jesus in Fresh Meadows and all of NYC!**
