CHALLENGE

Centerpoint Fellowship needed a kid-friendly check-in space that felt inviting and memorable.

As it was, the space offered little in terms of visual engagement for families arriving with young children.

GOAL

Design and produce a playful, welcoming environment around the primary entrance into the kid's area.

Reflect the energy and creativity of the children's ministry

Be durable and functional for a high-traffic area

Seamlessly integrate branding and wayfinding

PROCESS

Starting with the architectural layout, I created digital mockups to visualize how the space could transform into an imaginative playground-like scene.

- Stylized trees, clouds, and leaves to add vertical movement
- A playful tire swing and birdhouse for whimsical detail
- "Centerpoint Kids" logo integrated directly into the environment
- 3D shapes and layered elements for added depth and tactile interest
