Overview

The Unity Project is a nationwide organization dedicated to fighting for the rights of ALL oppressed communities. We feel our government has failed the American people and the only way forward is to build communities that rely on one another and not the Imperialist class that rules over us. We have realized that we can no longer rely on our elected representatives to do what is in our best interests and must take matters into our own hands. We are preparing for what could be some of the darkest times in our country's history. We also understand that peacefully protesting is not going to defeat fascism and have decided to take the only next logical step, which is preparing and protecting.

- 1. While we are not a violent movement, we will protect our communities at all costs. We are to teach the importance of having the means to protect yourself and your family against this fascist regime. While it is not a requirement to own/carry a firearm, we do encourage those willing to legally exercise your 2nd Amendment rights.**
- 2. We stand in solidarity with all oppressed communities. We do not deny anyone based on race, religion, sexual orientation, or gender.**
- 3. We are an organization that helps empower people and build them into their best possible selves. While arguments and disagreements will occur, we must realize that we can only grow if we listen to, and respect, one another. Tearing people down is counterproductive. But at the same time not everyone will be a good fit.**
- 4. We are all required to find ways we can help both local and national humanitarian organizations/efforts with a focus on educating the youth, sheltering the homeless, and feeding the hungry.**
- 5. We are fully dedicated to the protection of America's youth no matter the cost.**
- 6. We vow to protect/defend ALL marginalized communities from the fascist regime by any means necessary. Armed patrols may be required in some cases to make sure that these communities know we have their backs.**
- 7. We will remain peaceful, until peace is no longer an option.**
- 8. We will build rapid response units in all 50 states that are willing to be on the front lines. These units will respond to calls of ICE infestations. This will most likely be the most dangerous of positions and realistic expectations**

must be set for new members before they go into the field.

- 9. We will hold recruiting events whenever possible and Chapter leaders will be responsible for vetting new recruits. They will also be the ones held accountable for the actions of their recruits. This will ensure that each Chapter leader is careful who they surround themselves with. Chapter leaders will be vetted by the core members of the organization. NO Chapters will be started without our approval.**
- 10. We understand not everyone wants to be in the public eye and protecting those who do not is a top priority. Never put yourself in any more danger than you are willing to accept the consequences for. Those who are in the public eye need to understand the risks.**
- 11. We hope for the best while continuing to prepare for the worst. Most people have no idea what is about to happen. While we hope the worst doesn't happen, we are not naive and understand the evil we are up against. Our government does not care about us and has no intentions of saving us...it truly is up to the American people to save themselves.**
- 12. We are 100% community led and community fed. We do not accept help from local or state governments. We have realized that American democracy is broken and cannot allow corrupt politicians to use our organization to advance their personal agendas. We must hold ourselves to a much higher standard. We work for the people.**

Chapters

We will be creating Chapters in all 50 states plus the national hub which will be responsible for maintaining/enforcing standards for the entire country. While all are welcome to participate, Chapter leaders and their immediate crew will be the most at risk.

Each Chapter will be responsible for seeking out communities where they can help those in need.

Each Chapter will be responsible for providing sufficient security to make sure all involved in community activities are safe. While carrying firearms is optional, it is recommended for those providing the security(when the law permits).
