

ADVANTAGES

When should I upgrade to 26 Gauge Panels?

Panel Strength is a Top Priority. Hail and Winds are a Concern.

What are the benefits of staying with 29 Gauge?

Cost Savings

Panel Strength is not a top priority in your area, due to minimal Wind & Hail.

PBR Panel is the strongest panel offered, Ag Panel (26g) is a close second, while Ag Panel (29g) is the weakest panel offered relative to the panels offered. PBR Panel has a 1 1/4" raise compared to the Ag Panel's 3/4" raise. A taller raise gives PBR Panel the win in strength.



The thinner the Sheet Metal the more susceptible to wind and hail damage.



Both gauges offer Fire-Resistance, Steel Longevity, and Protection Against Corrosion.



An economical alternative is to get a 26 Gauge roof with 29 Gauge sides (% of base only).
