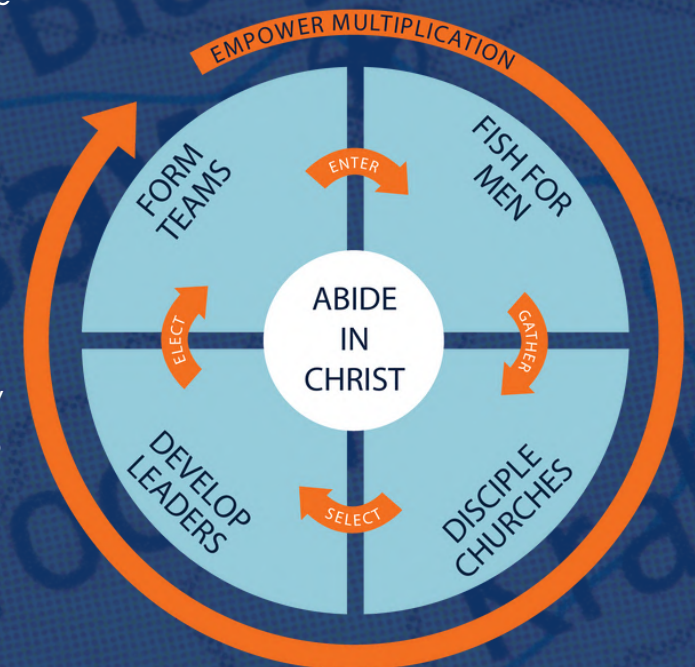
POLAND & UKRAINIAN REFUGEES

38 MILLION PEOPLE | 0.3% EVANGELICAL

Though there are many in Poland that know the name of Jesus, it is a staggering reality that only 0.3% of those who live there have the biblical understanding that Salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. Among the Polish, there are now 4.6 Million Ukrainian refugees that have fled from war to Poland.

OUR VISION

We want to see Christ worshipped and treasured through the making of disciples in the country of Poland. The Association of Baptists for World Evangelism (ABWE) exists to multiply leaders, churches, and mission movements among every people. The ABWE Team Poland will not only be making disciples among Polish citizens, but also has a unique opportunity to help establish Ukrainian Refugee churches, whose desire is to start a mission-movement by sending missionaries into Ukraine and Russia to proclaim the Gospel.
