IMPORTANT VOTING DEADLINES

SEPTEMBER 23RD - Clerk begins sending vote-by-mail (VBM) ballots to voters

OCTOBER 17TH - Deadline to register to vote in the General Election

OCTOBER 31ST - Deadline to apply for a vote-by-mail (VBM) ballot

OCTOBER 28TH - NOVEMBER 5TH - Early in-person voting period

NOVEMBER 6TH - Deadline to apply for vote-by-mail (VBM) ballot (in person by 3PM at the Clerk's office in your county)

NOVEMBER 7TH - Election day voting at your polling place

REGISTERING TO VOTE

CRITERIA FOR VOTING IN NJ:

- You must be a United States citizen.
- You must be at least 17 years old and understand that you may not vote until reaching the age of 18.
- You must be a resident of the county for 30 days before the election.
- You are NOT currently serving a sentence, probation, or parole because of a felony conviction.
- The registrant must complete a Voter Registration Application and/or Party Affiliation Form.

VOTER REGISTRATION - Find out if you are registered to vote **HERE**.

REGISTER ONLINE - To conveniently register to vote online click <u>HERE</u>. You will need a current, valid driver's license or a non-driver ID card, a social security number.

PRINT REGISTRATION - You can also print a registration form and send it in via mail to your County Clerk. Print a registration form <u>HERE</u>.

EARLY VOTING

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING - This option enables all registered voters to cast their ballot, in person, using a voting machine, prior to the General Election.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING DATES & TIMES - You may vote in person from October 28th - November 5th. Polling locations are open from 10:00 AM - 8:00 PM Monday - Saturday and 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM on Sundays.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING LOCATIONS - There are several places throughout the county where LD 16 residents can vote early. Check your county clerk office website for a list.

REASONS TO VOTE EARLY - To be sure your voice is heard, please vote early. Voting early helps you avoid lines at the polls and ensures that your vote is cast despite illness, traffic, voting machine issues, or any other unexpected incidents on Election Day. Vote *early*!

VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

ELECTION DAY POLLING LOCATIONS - Election day is Tuesday, November 7TH. Find your polling location by entering your address <u>HERE</u>.

APPLY TO VOTE BY MAIL - If you are not already a vote-by-mail (VBM) voter, but you would like to be, click <u>HERE</u> for an application.

DEADLINE TO REGISTER FOR VOTE-BY-MAIL - The deadline to apply for a VBM ballot is November 6TH (in person by 3PM at the Clerk's office in Somerville)
